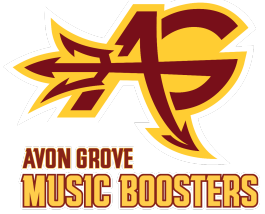

Call to Order

President Wendy Feller called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Director's and District Reports

- **Kyle Christy, Athletic and Activities Director**
 - No district updates. Michelle asked about access to live-stream during the upcoming home shows. Kyle confirmed this is possible and Michelle will send an email request.
 - What is the district policy about staff riding on the school bus? Kyle says that there should be one supplemental staff person per bus. If there is a problem, let Kyle know and he will try to help.
 - Kyle is working with the HS nurses on addressing concerns previously raised about managing student's medical needs during competitions, etc. More information will come.
 - They will not have access to trainers because the PIAA packet forms are what give the trainers the legal ability to treat the athletes. Likely moving to a contract, that would be limited to sports.

 - Congratulations to Chloe Ren and McKenzie Feller who participated in the PMEA District 12 Orchestra Festival on January 23-24. At reauditions, McKenzie Feller qualified for and will be attending the PMEA Region VI Orchestra Festival in Lower Merion. Congrats to both!

Treasurer's Report -

- Treasurer Matthew Miller presented on the status of the budget, including expenditures and fundraising income. Fundraising efforts have yielded slightly more than expected. Overall YTD, planned loss of just over 4000, but currently 5000 ahead. Overall YTD

Truck Status:

- **RaiseRight -**
RAISERIGHT REPORT for orders placed between 1/1/2026 - 1/31/2026
 - **18** families received gift card and non-gift card earnings during this time period!
 - Total earned in RaiseRight rebates was \$355.33.
 - Boosters made \$179.07, with no shipping expenses. \$176.27 went to student accounts.
 - Total income for Fiscal Year (July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026): \$3,252.38, which is split between Boosters and student accounts.
 - Total expenses for Fiscal Year: \$11shipping/ \$0 supplies (comes off booster rebates earned)

- **Indoor Shows**
 - The committee will be meeting immediately following the general meeting to finalize plans for the guard show on 2/14/26 and the percussion show on 2/28/26.

- **Spiritwear**
 - Indoor programs sale. Items were delivered to program directors this past Saturday. There was a misprint on the high school color guard show shirts that was a vendor error. Natalie has been in contact with the vendor who plans to reprint. The show shirts were handed out so they can be worn for the home show.

- Eric proposed consideration to issue personalized jugs with neoprene sleeves with a strap for all of the kids so they have the same one and don't have to purchase their own. Also need wagons for each section for the water bottles.
