



AGIMBA Fundraising with RaiseRight

Scrip is a simple and easy way to fundraise money for your students and raise money for AGIMBA. You can easily get and use Gift Cards and eGift Cards to earn a percentage every time. These are the same gift cards or certificates that you buy at the store. Participating retailers include Giant, Acme, WaWa, Lowe's, iTunes, Starbucks, CVS, and <u>hundreds</u> of others.

We are able to raise funds using RaiseRight because the participating retailers sell the gift cards to us at a discount. Families like yours buy the cards for full face value, redeem them for full face value, and the Boosters keep the difference as rebate. Half of this rebate is put into the Boosters' general fund and half goes into your student's account. Several families added more than \$300 to their student accounts from scrip alone.

Due to IRS regulations, you must complete a Scrip Program Agreement prior to placing your first order for each fiscal year. See the Booster website for a <u>copy of the Agreement</u>.

The RaiseRight program is simple and effective fundraising because:

- you don't have to go out and sell anything,
- you don't have to buy anything that you wouldn't already be buying, and
- it's a year-round source of funding.

The only thing it does require is some planning. Start small, buy a few grocery cards and maybe a card for the gas station or other retailer that you go to all the time. Then as you see how easy it is to use them (and how it adds up in your student's account), you can expand.

Ordering is easy and can be done right from your phone !:

Order via the RaiseRight App (Available on the Apple and Google apps stores), or on-line at <u>https://www.raiseright.com/</u>.

Ordering on-line provides you with a wealth of information including all the gift cards available, current specials (many retailers offer special incentive rebates at different times), the terms for each gift card/certificate, how to contact us with questions, and much more.

Orders and payments are due by 2:30 p.m. on the order due date of the month (this date will be announced at the beginning of each month) Any physical gift cards for Scrip is usually distributed to the students/parents one week later, and an email is sent to parents providing information on pick-up time and location.

Presto-Pay

Presto-Pay is a wonderfully convenient way for you to pay for your order on-line (debit your bank account) for a small fee of 0.15 per order. If you order on-line and pay with Presto-Pay, there is no need to send us anything, unless you want an alternate delivery method. Once you set up Presto-Pay (it takes a few days), you will still have the option to select your payment type each time you order. There are some cards that are reloadable. Current favorites are CVS, Starbucks and Lowe's. Different cards have different limits which are explained on <u>www.shopwithscrip.com</u>. Reloadable cards are especially convenient if you are enrolled in Presto-Pay. If you are placing an order that consists only of reloads, and you are paying by Presto-Pay, you can place your order at any time, and it will be processed right away. The money will be added to your card(s) usually overnight and, if they have your correct email address, ShopWithScrip will send you an email telling you that your card(s) has/have been reloaded. When reloading a card, please be absolutely sure to reload the correct card and to make sure that you actually have it as reloads are not refundable or transferable.

Please place your order early if at all possible. With the new school and other factors, we will be disabling the Pay Coordinator Directly option once this feature is available from RaiseRight. Please do not use this payment method. If you must pay by check, reach out to the Scrip Program Coordinator. We will never deposit your check before the order due date. Placing your order early assures that you won't miss the deadline (students forget to turn in orders – it happens every time), and it helps us to meet our processing deadlines. It also gives us time to contact you if there is a problem or question.

How to sign up

Because there is a requirement to fill out the Agreement form, you will be sent instructions on signing up via the email. Please send a copy of the agreement physically to the Scrip Program Chair, or electronically to <u>aghsscrip@gmail.com</u>. It is acceptable to take a picture of the signed agreement to attach via email, or use a phone app to scan it as a PDF.
