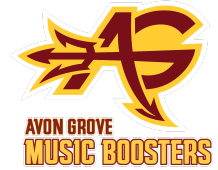

Policy: Student Awards

Purpose

This policy establishes a process for monetary student awards.

Scope

Each year, AGIMBA awards four equal scholarships to one graduating student from the Choir, Orchestra, Band, and Color Guard programs. These awards are contingent upon available funding and the approved annual budget.

Policy Steps

1. Each program director (Choir, Orchestra, Band, and Color Guard) may nominate one graduating student from their respective program via a check request to the AGIMBA Treasurer with the student's name and associated music program role.
2. The request is due approximately six weeks prior to the senior award ceremony.
3. The treasurer will verify that the student has no outstanding fees/dues for music program participation, and therefore is eligible for an award.
4. If ineligible, the director will be notified and may either nominate an alternate student or submit a written exception request detailing the reason for the request.
5. Exception request approval requires a majority vote by the Executive Committee.
6. Once eligibility is verified or an exception request is approved, the Treasurer will confirm the award via email to the directors and Executive Committee.
